Universal Fit Buckets

Typical universal lift truck buckets connect to forks that are up to 6" wide and are 48" long. Bigger fork pockets can be prearranged via an account executive upon request.

Since universal fit lift truck buckets slip onto the forks directly, they stay on the machinery and are much less at risk to damage. These buckets are also 50% deeper as opposed to the quick-tach bucket models. This extra space makes them ideal for carrying irregular shaped loads like moving large debris piles, broken up concrete, backfilling behind walls, tearing of roof trash and elevating roof gravel.

Quick-Tach Buckets

Quick-Tach Buckets are made for extendable-reach forklifts. They are built to allow placement of material way beyond the reach of a loader. A hardened beveled cutting blade on both sides and on the leading edge reinforces stability, resistance to wear and offers supreme durability. Quick-Tach forklift buckets are enhanced by scuff bars along the base of the unit that shield it from scratches.

Quick-Tach lift buckets can in several situations replace the forks and carriage of a forklift, which may weigh somewhere between 100-700lbs. These buckets when installed can free up more load capacity, enabling it to deal with both larger and heavier items. The Quick-Tach is able to dump stuff around 1.5 feet higher due to the shorter depth of its bucket. These buckets are designed in a customized fashion to be able to suit the specifications of specific makes and models of lifts.
